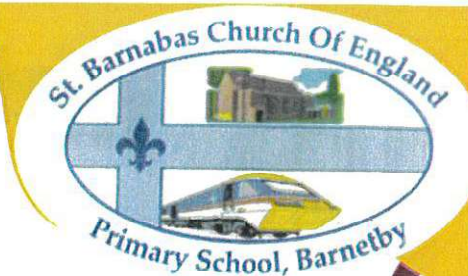

What went well today?

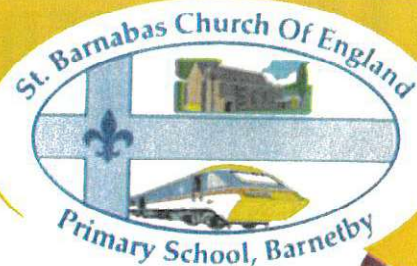
What was the best bit today?
